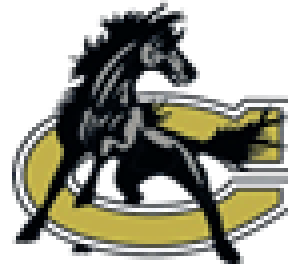


Guidance News
